

Citizens and persons with acquired status, who may enter the territory of the Republic of Bulgaria upon submission of a document showing a negative result from a polymerase chain reaction test (PCR test) conducted up to 72 hours before entry into the country or a negative result from a conducted up to 48 hours before entering the country rapid antigen test for proving COVID-19 , as of the date of the test, entered in the document (according to item I, 6 of Order RD-01-416 of 04.06.2021 of the Minister of Health):

1. Bulgarian citizens and members of their families (including persons who are in actual cohabitation with them);
2. Citizens of Member States of the European Union (EU) and members of their families (including persons who are in actual cohabitation with them);
3. Citizens of the Schengen Parties (including the Republic of San Marino, the Principality of Andorra, the Principality of Monaco and the Vatican City State) and members of their families (including persons who are in actual cohabitation with them);
4. Citizens of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland;
5. Citizens of the Australian Union;
6. Citizens of Canada;
7. Citizens of the United States of America;
8. Citizens of Japan;
9. Citizens of New Zealand;
10. Citizens of the People's Republic of China;
11. Citizens of the Republic of Rwanda;
12. Citizens of the Republic of Korea;
13. Citizens of the Kingdom of Thailand;
14. Citizens of the Republic of Tunisia;
15. Citizens of the Eastern Republic of Uruguay;
16. Citizens of the United Arab Emirates;
17. Citizens of Georgia;
18. Citizens of Ukraine;
19. Citizens of the Republic of North Macedonia;
20. Citizens of the Republic of Serbia;
21. Citizens of the Republic of Albania;

32. Persons who are holders of a Bulgarian long-term residence visa type "D";
33. Persons who have a residence permit in a Member State of the European Union and their family members;

34. Persons who have a residence permit in a country under the Schengen Agreement (including the Republic of San Marino, the Principality of Andorra, the Principality of Monaco and the Vatican State) and their family members.

Important:

The option is only provided for persons who are not arriving from India, Bangladesh, Nepal, Myanmar, Bhutan, Sri Lanka, Pakistan, Maldives, Brazil and other countries and territories in Africa for which entry is prohibited.

The document, from the polymerase chain reaction method or rapid antigen test for proving COVID-19, must contain the names of the person, written in Latin, according to the identity document with which he travels, data about the medical institution that performed the examination (name, address or other contact details), date on which performed the test, written in Latin method (PCR) or rapid antigen test of those listed in Annex № 2 and a negative result (Negative), allowing interpretation of the document.
